To Whom It May Concern:


I am writing on behalf of my patients Katherine and Faith Arrich who live on Bell Road in Culpeper VA. It has come to my attention that low grade biosolids are to be spread on the field across the street from their home.

I am asking that the decision to spread these biosolids be reconsidered. Though this industry is heavily regulated there are no checks in the Commonwealth testing biosolids which come in to the Commonwealth. It is my understanding that the Commonwealth relies on the standards of other states in allowing biosolids to come in to Virginia.

The potential risks of airborne spread of bacterial and viral pathogens is a concern for these patients and for their neighbors who suffer with chronic respiratory illnesses.

Thank you for reconsidering the use of biosolids in this area.
