
To Whom It May Concern:

Dear Ms. Woods:



If you have any authority on this question and can suggest to the local farmers that they use alternative, non-aerosolizing fertilizer, that would be helpful to

I have also discussed with her that she might want to consider moving to a less rural locale to avoid the exposure that is presently causing her health problems.
